
## **BELUU Innovation Grant Judging Committee**

The BELUU Innovation Grant is an award and funding facility providing financial and technical assistance in Tuvalu, Nauru, Marshall Islands, and Palau.

- Each country shall have at least 1 Innovation Grant recipient. \*
- \* Total of 17-19 innovation grants will be awarded.
- \* Innovation projects may last from 6 to 18 months.

The BELUU team will incorporate a judging or selection process to incorporate insights of various WEE experts, organization wide experience as well as knowledge on Pacific Region themes or advocacies. Judges will use discretion in evaluating the grant applications and shall be using a blind process where the applicant's name or organization is redacted.
